Rampart Institute, founded on April 19, 1980, is a tax-exempt, tax-deductible, educational organization dedicated to the promotion of personal and economic liberty. It is operated by three directors: Robert LeFevre, author and founder of Rampart College, Richard Deyo, an attorney from Norwalk, California and Lawrence Samuels, Executive Director of Society for Libertarian Life (based at California State University, Fullerton). The main purposes of **Rampart Institute** consist of the following:

- 1. To open and operate a *Freedom Library* consisting mostly of Robert LeFevre's personal library (books and journals will be sought from other sources). LeFevre will buy back his personal library if a building is obtained somewhere in Southern California (best location would be in Orange County).
- 2. To promote and publish a series of books which comprise of LeFevre's best newspaper and magazine articles.
- 3. To publish a quarterly (later monthly) journal to keep members and supporters in touch with developments at the institute.
- 4. To co-sponsor the annual Future of Freedom Conference series at local universities.
- 5. To provide with the *Freedom Library* a bookstore, lecture room and research room (as well as an office to conduct the programs of **Rampart Institute**.
- 6. To develop, if funds are available, short 30 minute films to promote libertarian ideals. Some of the material for scripts could be provided from some of the books written by LeFevre.
- 7. To develop small seminar series on college campuses for students going into professional and academic (teaching) fields.

The goals and purposes listed above are just the beginning. With sufficient funding, **Rampart Institue** can become a major influence in academic circles and in the community. We need your support to do this very important work.
