EVENING LECTURE: "THE STATE OF THE ECONOMY"

In this general public lecture, Harry Browne will explain current economic conditions, covering such topics as:

- why a 1929-type crash is now possible
- why retail prices will probably rise 25-50% in 1975
- why it isn't too late to protect yourself
